RECENT HISTORY OF VIOLENCE AGAINST THE JEWS OF FRANCE

1980

Palestinian terrorists bomb the rue de Copernic synagogue during Friday night services, murdering four and wounding 46.

2002

In the week leading up to Passover, five synagogues throughout France were attacked. One synagogue was burned to the ground, while others suffered serious damage.

2006

Ilan Halimi, 23—Kidnapped, tortured for 23 days and murdered by a gang of Islamist extremists calling themselves “the barbarians.”

2012

A terrorist motivated by Islamist extremism shoots and kills a rabbi and three children outside a Jewish school.

2014

Antisemitic riots take place with mobs shouting “death to Jews,” attacking Jews and damaging Jewish-owned businesses.

2015

Four people murdered in a kosher supermarket by the same ISIS terrorists who perpetrated the Charlie Hebdo massacre.

2017

Sarah Halimi was a 66-year-old French Jewish retired doctor and schoolteacher who was tortured and murdered by a man who later said he was upset by her mezuzah. He was heard shouting “Allahu Akbar” by neighbors as he attacked Sarah. He was deemed not criminally responsible because he smoked weed.

2018

Tombstones at a Jewish cemetery are defaced with antisemitic graffiti.

2018

85-year-old Holocaust survivor Mireille Knoll is stabbed to death and burned in her Paris apartment by an Islamist terrorist. At least in that case, the authorities in France said it was an antisemitic hate crime.

2019

An Israeli student in Paris is beaten unconscious on the Metro after he was heard speaking Hebrew on his phone.

2020

At an anti-racism rally in Paris, some protesters started chanting “DIRTY JEW.”
