

During the Camp David Negotiations

in July 2000, Israeli Prime Minister Ehud Barak offered the Palestinians 100 percent of the Gaza Strip, 95 percent of a contiguous West Bank (with land swaps), the removal of Jewish communities from those areas, and \$30 billion to help resettle Palestinian refugees. The Palestinians rejected the offer.
